#### STARTING NINE- NEWS AND NOTES

- Last Time Out: An eighth-inning deadlock turned into a 6-2 Chiefs win on Saturday. Peoria scored five runs over the game's final two innings to secure a series win over Quad Cities. Ryan Campos and lan Petrutz each drove in two Chiefs tallies.
- Got Your Number: Though they have been one of the league's best in 2025, the Chiefs have taken it to Quad Cities of late. The Chiefs have won seven straight against the Bandits dating back to June 5. In that stretch, Peoria has outscored Quad Cities 47-22. Tre Richardson, who drove in a run on Friday, is 12-for-26 (.462) over the winning streak.
- Tone Setters: The starting pitching has set the tone for the Chiefs since coming out of the All-Star break. Jason Savacool and Jose Davila have combined to allow just four hits and one run over 10 innings of work. Davila, who took the ball on Sturday, did not surrender a hit over four scoreless innings.
- A Historic Decision: Last night's win went to Peoria-born Mason Burns, who retired all four batters he faced out of the bullpen. Burns became the first Peoria-born player to ever record a win for the Chiefs. He joined Joe Girardi as the only native Peorian to ever suit up for the Chiefs when he debuted on July 3.
- Put it in Play: The Chiefs have been among the league's best at putting the ball in play and avoiding the strikeout. They put that on full display as they whiffed just one time in last night's victory. Only three MiLB clubs have gone an entire game without striking out this season, including the Midwest League's Lansing Lugnuts. It was the first time since May of 2023 that Peoria punched out once or fewer, when they did it at Cedar Rapids.
- Don't Kross Him: Josh Kross drove in another run in Saturday's win. Since his promotion to Peoria on June 3, the switch hitter has driven in 33 runs, the most in the Midwest League. One of the most prolific power bats in the Cardinals system, the 2024 draftee leads all Cardinals minor leaguers in home runs (14), RBIs (70) and XBH (34)
- July Jolt: After working through the first slump of his professional career, lan Petrutz has picked it up in July. In 20 June contests, Petrutz hit just .205 and had an OPS of .597. Through 12 July games, the outfielder has driven in 12 runs and owns an OPS of .815.
- Welcome to Peoria: Southpaw Braden Davis will make his High-A debut on Sunday as the Chiefs look to sweep a three-game series from Quad Cities. Davis was lights out for Single-A Palm Beach in 2025, punching out 97 batters over 69.0 innings, a 12.7 K/9. Davis has whiffed 10 or more hitters twice this season, inclduing his final start with Palm Beach on July 8, when he racked up 11 strikeouts against Dunedin (TOR).
- A Viral Moment: Dozer Park and the Peoria Chiefs recently went viral. Following a July 3 home game, 85-year-old Tom Persich, a West Peoria native, ran the bases postgame. His trot around the bases has been featured by MLB, People Magazine and the NBC Nightly News.

### TOP STORIES OF 2025

- April 6- Infielder Johnfrank Salazar faced eight Quad Cities batters and took the loss for Peoria on April 6. The first baseman topped out at 88 MPH on the bump. It was the first time since September 4, 2017 that a Chiefs position player factored into a decision for the club. Sunday's game also marked the first time since 2015 that Peoria had two position players throw in the same game. Graysen Tarlow also recorded an out on the mound.
- May 11- After beginning the year on the IL, Cardinals No. 13 prospect Chen-Wei Lin made his High-A debut on Mother's Day. The hard-throwing Lin topped out at 101 MPH on the radar gun and recorded eight outs in his season debut.
- May 13- The Chiefs plated eight runs in the top of the eighth inning to score a wild 13-10 win over the Cedar Rapids Kernels. In the process, the offense did something that hadn't been accomplished by a Chiefs team in more than 20 years. All nine batters drove in a run in the victory. No player drove in more than two runs for Peoria. The Chiefs logged 18 hits in the ballgame.
- May 18- In Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids, skipper Roberto Espinoza logged his 200th managerial win. Espinoza, who is in his first season with the Chiefs, previously managed the Johnson City Cardinals (2017-19) and the FCL Cardinals (2021-24). The 36-year-old led Johnson City to a league title in 2019.
- May 20- The Chiefs wore their hitting shoes in a rain-shortened 12-5 win over Dayton, mashing a single-game franchise record seven home runs. Joshua Baez and Zach Levenson each connected on a pair of homers. Ian Petrutz, Brayden Jobert and Tre Richardson also chipped in. The previous record was six home runs, a feat most recently accomplished in 2022 at Cedar Rapids.
- ♦ June 8- Peoria pushed its winning streak to five games after sweeping a doubleheader from Quad Cities at Dozer Park. The Chiefs scored 18 runs over just 12 innings of at-bats. The Chiefs swept a pair of doubleheaders from the Bandits, the first time since 2018 that Peoria took two twin bills from the same team in the same series.
- July 2- The Chiefs turned in a historic performance, blasting the South Bend Cubs 21-2. The 21 runs were a Chiefs single-game record at Dozer Park and just three runs off of the franchise record (August 28, 1984 at Quad Cities). Josh Kross launched a grand slam and drove in six runs in the victory. The Chiefs broke the 20-run mark for the first time since September 2, 2004, a 20-7 win over Wisconsin.
- July 3- Relief pitcher Mason Burns joined a very exclusive club when he made his Chiefs debut on July 3. Burns became just the second Peoria-born player to ever suit up for the Chiefs, joining former MLB catcher Joe Girardi (1986, 2003 rehab). A graduate of Normal Community High School, Burns twirled a scoreless inning in his High-A debut.
